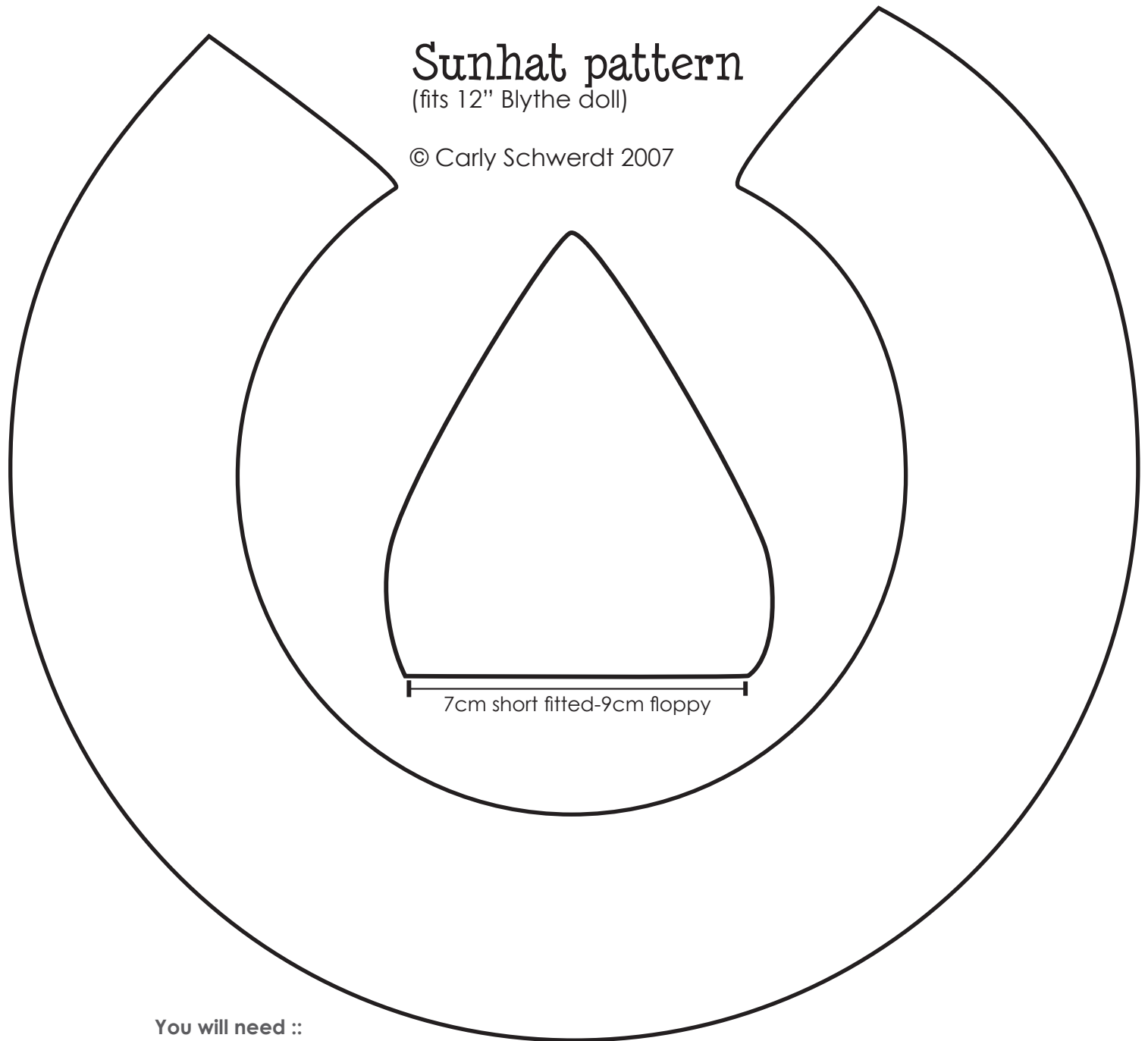


Sunhat pattern

(fits 12" Blythe doll)

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You will need ::

needle and thread/ machine

2 complimentary fabrics (maybe one plain and one patterned)

How to make ::

1 trace & cut this pattern out of baking paper.

2 pin pattern pieces to fabric A, cut brim only once and cap piece X5 (I cheat and lay 5 pieces of fabric together and cut out all at once... you need good sharp scissors)

3 repeat step 2 with fabric B

4 sew (by hand or machine) all 5 cap pieces (fabric A) edge to edge until it forms the cap.

5 sew the brim to the cap... you can either sew up the brim's ends before or after... if you sew it up after like me (to avoid bunching) remember to stop sewing it to the cap with a 1cm gap so that you have room to sew up the ends.

6 repeat step 5 with fabric B

7 face the hats together and sew at the brim, leaving a hole to turn right side out

8 once turned right side out you can also quilt the brim to give it that nice stiffness.
